On October 1, 2007, at 11:29 pm, two white males ages nineteen and twenty, were stabbed while on the red line platform at Park Street MBTA Station. Both victims sustained single stab wounds to their abdomen. Their injuries are considered non-life threatening; however, one of the victims underwent exploratory surgery.

Suspect #1 is described as a white male, 5'10"-5'11", eighteen to twenty-one years of age, wearing a red and white hat, (recovered on scene by the Transit Police), a red zippered sweatshirt over a red t-shirt with white lettering, blue jeans and white sneakers. **Suspect #2** is described as a white male, 5'7"-5'8", wearing a white hooded sweatshirt and a white baseball cap. **Suspect #3** is described as a white female, dark hair, wearing a green t-shirt, blue jeans and carrying a blue purse.

The images shown above were captured from the MBTA CCTV camera system and depict the suspects as they entered the Government Center MBTA Station just prior to the stabbing.
