

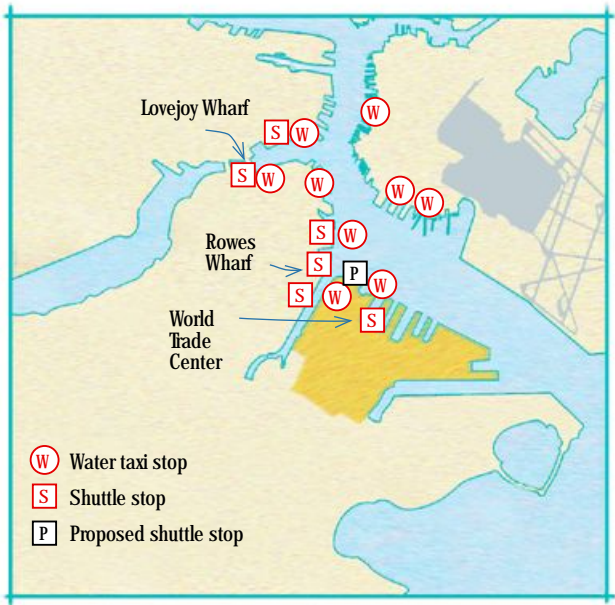
**PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

The Silver Line, scheduled to open in 2002, will run from South Station to Fan Pier and the World Trade Center - and may one day extend from Dudley Square to Logan Airport.



**COMMUTER BOATS**

Water transport is limited in scope but popular with riders, and it's easily expanded as demand rises. Water shuttles and taxis now run from the airport to Rowes Wharf and Quincy, from Hingham to Boston, and from Lovejoy Wharf near North Station to the World Trade Center, among other routes.



**MOTOR VEHICLES**

A further extension of the Mass. Pike Extension, with an exit in the Seaport District, will connect with the Ted Williams Tunnel in late 2001. The new Bypass Road, which diverts construction traffic from neighborhood streets, may be extended eastward toward the Conley freight terminal.
